

- Technique used to guide the reader
- Types of signposting:
- Major signposting: explicit sentences used in introductions,
 conclusions, main body of the text
- 2. Small scale signposting: linking words and phrases employed throughout paragraphs

Clarity: provides a clear understanding of your structure

• Coherence and cohesion: helps with flow of argument and gives a logical structure

Academic voice and confidence: makes the reader
